# CLUB HISTORY 1898-2025

The club was founded in 1898, initially playing close to the Rhinefield Ornamental Drive. The Badgers were founder members of the New Forest League which they won a number of times. They moved before World War 1 to a site between the Rose and Crown and Snakecatcher pubs. Following the war the club played in both the Bournemouth and Hampshire leagues, moving to Fathersfield. In 1931 they were forced to move again, to Black Knoll when Fathersfield was given over to housing. In 1935 the club won the New Forest Lads Cup. Within two years the Badgers moved to Oberfield and after World War 2 they spent some seasons at Tile Barn before moving to their current home at Grigg Lane in 1951.

The club were crowned Hampshire League Division Three champions in 1960 as well as winning the Bournemouth Seniors cup. They moved between the Second and Third divisions until in 1971 they were promoted to Division One where they won the league title in the 1975-76 season. Brockenhurst were founder members of the Wessex League, joining in 1986. The club's FA Cup giant killing reached its pinnacle in season 2001/02 when Kingstonian were defeated and in season 2004/05 the club reached the 3<sup>rd</sup> qualifying round, the run ending in defeat to Bath City.

In season 2012/13 the club returned to the Wessex Premier Division as Division One champions and reached the final of both the Southampton DFA Senior Cup and the Wessex League Cup. The Badgers won three cups in three years—in season 2019/20 the team won the Bournemouth Senior Cup; in 2020/21 we lifted the Hampshire Senior Invitational Supplementary Cup; and in 2021/22 we won the Russell-Cotes Cup. In 2020/21, both the U18 and U17 teams won their divisions. Season 2021/22 was one of the most successful for Brockenhurst in recent years, with the club finishing 6<sup>th</sup> in the Premier Division, getting to the last 16 in the FA Vase and winning the Russell-Cotes Cup. Brockenhurst celebrated its 125<sup>th</sup> season in 2023/24, and missed out on the promotion playoffs by goal difference only. At the end of the season, long-serving manager Pat McManus left the club; a successful and enjoyable testimonial match was held for Pat in July 2024.

We recently appointed Steve Devlin as first-team manager of Brockenhurst. We have retained the core of the squad from last year's campaign, and added experience, some returning players and a number of promising players. The future looks bright for The Badgers.

# HAMBLE CLUB HISZORY

More than one year has been traced for the formation of HAMBLE CLUB but it is 1969 that is presently deemed to be correct. Formed as Hamble FC they made steady progress through the Southampton Junior Leagues before merging with a Sunday team, called Hamble Club and adopted their name in 1981.

From the senior divisions, Hamble Club were promoted to the Hampshire League in 1993. They moved from their Mount Pleasant base to the Old College Fields and made a further move to what was then known as the Shell-Mex Ground during the 2002/03 season which remains their present home.

Wessex members between 2004 and 2007, Hamble became Hampshire Premier League founders but they failed to complete the 2012/13 season and had to start a division lower. But this heralded the start of an upturn as they gained four promotions in five years, including one in their first season back in the Wessex League in 2017.

The club was established in 1969, originally as a youth team. In 1993 they joined Division Three of the Hampshire League. The club were Division Three champions in 1996/97, earning promotion to Division Two. In 2004 the Hampshire League merged into the Wessex League, with Hamble becoming members of the new Division Three.

In 2006 the division was renamed Division Two, but at the end of the 2006 –07 the division was disbanded and the club became founder members of the Hampshire Premier League.

Hamble pulled out of the Hampshire Premier League during the 2012/13 season. Although they were readmitted the following season, they started in the newly formed second tier of the league, Division One. The club were Division One runners-up in 2013/14 and were promoted to

The club were Division One runners-up in 2013/14 and were promoted to the Senior Division and went on to win the Senior Division in 2014/15. After finishing third the following season they were promoted to Division One and then were Division One champions in 2016/17, earning promotion to the Premier Division.

Further silverware followed in 2023/24, when the club won the Wessex League Cup for the first time, beating AFC Portchester in the final at the Wicor Recreation Ground.

Progression continued in to 2024/25 as The Monks reached the play-off final following a Wessex-high finish of fourth - but just came up short with defeat against Fareham Town at Cams Alders.

# LAST TIME OUT ...

JON RENYARD'S REVIEW OF EAST COWES VICTORIA V BROCKENHURST-14 OCTOBER 2025

This was a hugely impressive away performance, three comfortable points and a winning margin which could probably have been greater than 3-0. There was some early pressure from Vics, a good block from Brooks – but shortly afterwards Speechley-Price headed against the bar and on 15 minutes the Badgers took the lead when Freddie Beale, a livewire all evening, cut inside from the right and hit a powerful shot, saved by Ram but the rebound put away by Dylan Walker. Brock then largely kept the hosts at arm's length for the remainder of the half, marshalled superbly by Bailey and Holmes in midfield supported by Rossi and Speechley-Price in an unaccustomed centre back pairing. A moment of controversy shortly before the break when Triggs appeared to pass the ball back to Ram, who collected it – the referee (who had a solid game) was more concerned about a possible injury to Mason and the moment passed. HT 0-1 In truth, Brock should have been further ahead at the interval and will have been disappointed by the narrow margin. They soaked up some early pressure in the second half but should have extended their lead when Holmes set Walker free, he burned past his defender and a tap-in for Mason looked certain but somehow the ball went behind the striker and was cleared. Vics were putting in plenty of endeavour but there was nothing on target as the visiting defence stood firm... and then on 59 minutes, Beale went on another of those trademark twinkle-toes runs, taken out in the box, penalty duly converted by Mitch Speechley-Price. That always looked likely to be enough: Wright curled a shot over the bar from the edge of the box, Snow ran through most of the half before being tackled before he could get his shot away, and then with seven to go, Scrimshaw found his way into the box... he went down under a challenge, "seen'em given" but the ball broke loose to Bricknell eight yards out and his scuffed shot went straight at Valero. Still time for the first 8-second countdown corner we've seen this season – Valero judged to have taken too long – but the ball was cleared, Brock won a corner at the other end, superbly headed home by Toby Colmer for a 3-0 scoreline which didn't flatter the Badgers. And even then there was time for a Beale shot, excellent save from Ram, before the final whistle. FT 0-3
