CLUB HISTORY 1898-2024

The club was founded in 1898, initially playing close to the Rhinefield Ornamental Drive. The Badgers were founder members of the New Forest League which they won a number of times. They moved before World War 1 to a site between the Rose and Crown and Snakecatcher pubs. Following the war the club played in both the Bournemouth and Hampshire leagues, moving to Fathersfield. In 1931 they were forced to move again, to Black Knoll when Fathersfield was given over to housing. In 1935 the club won the New Forest Lads Cup. Within two years the Badgers moved to Oberfield and after World War 2 they spent some seasons at Tile Barn before moving to their current home at Grigg Lane in 1951.

The club were crowned Hampshire League Division Three champions in 1960 as well as winning the Bournemouth Seniors cup. They moved between the Second and Third divisions until in 1971 they were promoted to Division One where they won the league title in the 1975-76 season. Brockenhurst were founder members of the Wessex League, joining in 1986. The club's FA Cup giant killing reached its pinnacle in season 2001/02 when Kingstonian were defeated and in season 2004/05 the club reached the 3rd qualifying round, the run ending in defeat to Bath City.

In season 2012/13 the club returned to the Wessex Premier Division as Division One champions and reached the final of both the Southampton DFA Senior Cup and the Wessex League Cup. The Badgers won three cups in three years—in season 2019/20 the team won the Bournemouth Senior Cup; in 2020/21 we lifted the Hampshire Senior Invitational Supplementary Cup; and in 2021/22 we won the Russell-Cotes Cup. In 2020/21, both the U18 and U17 teams won their divisions. Season 2021/22 was one of the most successful for Brockenhurst in recent years, with the club finishing 6th in the Premier Division, getting to the last 16 in the FA Vase and winning the Russell-Cotes Cup.

Brockenhurst celebrated its 125th season in 2023/24, and missed out on the promotion playoffs by goal difference only. At the end of the season, long-serving manager Pat McManus left the club; a successful and enjoyable testimonial match for Pat was held in July 2024.

Danny Ackland has now become the manager of Brockenhurst; we have retained many of the players from last year's positive campaign, and have made some great signings too. The future looks bright for The Badgers.

LAST TIME OUT

JON RENYARD'S REVIEW OF US PORTSMOUTH V BROCKENHURST —18 JANUARY 2025

A bitingly cold afternoon, two teams who aren't in the best form, a total attendance of just 37: doesn't sound auspicious does it? The game started slowly, with neither side able to gain any kind of dominance, but gradually Brock did start to gain the ascendency, and a goal looked likely. Owen cut out a very dangerous cross on 27 minutes; Drake headed straight at Craig on 28; but on 30 minutes the breakthrough, a pass slid through to Simpson who lifted the ball over the keeper – keeper got something on it, but not enough to divert the ball. A second might have followed, Bunce with a fantastic run down the right, ball pulled back to Gray, whose shot went high. The hosts did have a brief flurry before half-time, but no chances created. HT 0-1

Brock started the second period brightly – Gray (best player on the pitch) played Simpson in within two minutes of the restart but his shot went agonisingly wide of the far post... but then US Portsmouth put some serious pressure on the Badgers defence. Valero was called into action on several occasions, and there was some careless play in the midfield which saw the ball come back with increasing frequency. 50 minutes, Orepo with a low shot which whistled just the wrong wide of the post... 60 minutes, Cummings with a shot which came off the far post, rolled along the goal line, hit the other post and was grabbed by a grateful Valero. 63 minutes, Kelly with a free kick 3 yards outside the box – brilliantly saved. A second Brock goal wasn't out of the question, a lovely break ending when Adams chipped to the back post and just beyond Simpson – but the hosts were on top... yet another break down the right, another pull-back, Jake Walker hit the bar. A minute later, Scammel skied his shot from inside the box. Final 15, all a bit breathless... and then the controversy. Sub Dylan Walker went down in an incident with the ball out of play – none of us saw what had happened but the ref consulted with his assistant and Kyle was sent off. And if that didn't end the game as a contest, this did: 86 minutes, Rhys Taylor, on the far touchline, swung in a dangerous cross which cannoned off the far post and into the net. One of those where they'll tell the TV interviewer they meant it, and try to keep a straight face. Either way, it secured the points. FT 0-2


