CLUB HISTORY 1898-2025

The club was founded in 1898, initially playing close to the Rhinefield Ornamental Drive. The Badgers were founder members of the New Forest League which they won a number of times. They moved before World War 1 to a site between the Rose and Crown and Snakemaster pubs. Following the war the club played in both the Bournemouth and Hampshire leagues, moving to Farnhamfield. In 1931 they were forced to move again, to Black Knoll when Farnhamfield was given over to housing. In 1935 the club won the New Forest Lads Cup. Within two years the Badgers moved to Oberfield and after World War 2 they spent some seasons at Tile Barn before moving to their current home at Grigg Lane in 1951.

The club were crowned Hampshire League Division Three champions in 1960 as well as winning the Bournemouth Seniors cup. They moved between the Second and Third divisions until in 1971 they were promoted to Division One where they won the league title in the 1975-76 season. Brockenhurst were founder members of the Wessex League, joining in 1986. The club's FA Cup giant killing reached its pinnacle in season 2001/02 when Kingstonian were defeated and in season 2004/05 the club reached the 3rd qualifying round, the run ending in defeat to Bath City.

In season 2012/13 the club returned to the Wessex Premier Division as Division One champions and reached the final of both the Southampton DFA Senior Cup and the Wessex League Cup. The Badgers won three cups in three years—in season 2019/20 the team won the Bournemouth Senior Cup; in 2020/21 we lifted the Hampshire Senior Invitational Supplementary Cup; and in 2021/22 we won the Russell-Cotes Cup. In 2020/21, both the U18 and U17 teams won their divisions. Season 2021/22 was one of the most successful for Brockenhurst in recent years, with the club finishing 6th in the Premier Division, getting to the last 16 in the FA Vase and winning the Russell-Cotes Cup. Brockenhurst celebrated its 125th season in 2023/24, and missed out on the promotion playoffs by goal difference only. At the end of the season, long-serving manager Pat McManus left the club; a successful and enjoyable testimonial match was held for Pat in July 2024.

We recently appointed Steve Devlin as first-team manager of Brockenhurst. We have retained the core of the squad from last year's campaign, and added experience, some returning players and a number of promising players. The future looks bright for The Badgers.

BEMERTON HEATH HARLEQUINS CLUB HISTORY

Bemerton Heath Harlequins were established in May 1989, following the merger of three well-respected local clubs: Bemerton Athletic, Moon F.C., and Bemerton Boys. Soon after the club formation, a clubhouse was constructed, providing a vital hub for players, staff, and fans.

Since its formation, Bemerton Heath Harlequins have been a consistent presence in the Wessex League, earning a reputation as a well-organized, competitive team.

The 1992/93 season remains one of the most memorable in the club's history. That year, the team achieved a third-place finish in the league, lifted the Wiltshire Senior Cup, and completed a hat-trick of Hospital Cup Final victories. They also enjoyed notable runs in both the F.A. Cup and the F.A. Vase. In 1997/98 the first team built on this momentum, finishing fifth in the Wessex League and reaching the Wessex League Cup final.

A significant milestone came in the 1998/99 season, when Bemerton advanced to the last 16 of the F.A. Vase for the first time in the club's history. In December 2020, Shaun Hale was appointed as First Team Manager, with Ian Saunders transitioning into a Director of Football role. Under Hale's leadership, Bemerton achieved a historic milestone, winning the Wessex Division 1 championship in 2021/22—the club's first-ever league title.

The momentum carried into the next season, with Bemerton finishing second in 2022/23, securing back-to-back promotions and earning a place in the Southern League for the first time in their history. These achievements marked a new era of success and ambition for the club.

As the 2024/25 season approached, Bemerton Heath Harlequins underwent significant leadership changes. Shaun Hale stepped down as First Team Manager. In response, the club turned to Danny Young, appointing him as Interim Manager. Young brought a wealth of Southern League experience, providing stability during a period of transition.

Following a thorough recruitment process, James Milligan was appointed as the club's new First Team Manager in October 2024. Milligan transformed the team's fortunes, lifting them from the lower half of the table into playoff contention. However, after his success, he ultimately returned to his hometown club, Shaftesbury FC.

In January 2025, Bemerton made another key addition by bringing in Luke Platt, a manager they had long admired. A UEFA A Licence Manager and Coach, Platt's résumé was filled with experience at both non-league and professional levels.



Ultimately, the Badgers booked their Southampton Senior Cup semi-final place with something to spare, despite a bit of a scare early in the second half. A lightning start: 34 seconds on the clock when Brock took the lead, Brooks hit the post from a tight angle and Connor Dunesby-Bent was on hand to tuck home the rebound. Hosts firmly in the ascendant at this point and on 11, Brock played a corner back to the edge of the box which reached Torniainen and his shot sneaked in for 2-0. Out of nowhere, a gift of a goal for the visitors on 16 minutes. MacFarlane underhit a short pass to Valero and Lee Vint was onto it – initial shot well saved by Valero but Vint was able to knock the rebound home from a yard. While the early dominance had gone, Brock were still creating chances and on 44 minutes a Colmer cross, Speechley-Price at the back post, 3-1. But then a few seconds into injury time, Speechley-Price went in for a challenge, appeared to slip at the last minute, took his man out – and was given a straight red. It felt quite harsh, but it's there in the record books... HT 3-1

Understandably, Ringwood came out fired up for the second half. A couple of personnel changes seemed to upset Brock's defensive rhythm – being down to ten didn't help, no doubt, but the Badgers were sitting too deep and encouraging the opposition onto them – and duly paid the price on 54 minutes when Dan May, Ringwood's most influential player on the night, reacted quickest to a loose ball and fired home from the edge of the box. The Badgers were rocking, and needed someone to grab the game and take charge. Step forward Toby Colmer, who became increasingly influential from this point on, running the midfield almost single-handedly with running being the operative word, incredible energy. The hosts extended their lead on 66 with a very neat move, McCarthy-Gardiner's cross deflected off a defender to Mason, who set up Colmer for 4-2. Five minutes on, a corner headed out only to the edge of the box, Luke Gray with the shot, 5-2. Any doubts about the outcome were now dispelled, and Brock almost scored the goal of the night – superb run from Colmer down the left, outstanding defence-splitting pass through to Mason, but White managed to spread himself and save. Ringwood didn't give up and Valero made some fine saves, twice from Kerse and then Whitelaw, but it wasn't Ringwood's night.


