VIEW FROM THE STANDS

Welcome to the Meadens Škoda Arena and matchday 18 of our Velocity Wessex Premier League season (hasn't that gone quickly). We'd like to extend a particular welcome to the players, officials and supporters of Bournemouth, commonly known as the Poppies. This is the return match, of course, the Badgers having visited Victoria Park at the start of the season, and – well, let's just say that many things from that occasion are best left in the past, and we hope that our visitors enjoy their afternoon with us. At the time of writing, no sponsor has been confirmed for the game, which is a shame. Hopefully someone will come forward before kick-off, because recent form suggests that the decision about man of the match won't be an easy one and may need a wise adjudicator, rather than being left to the popular vote! Brock have definitely been on an upward curve lately – four straight league wins followed by two draws against tricky opponents, currently sitting comfortably in the top half of the table and just outside the playoff places on goal difference, although the eagle-eyed will have noticed that we've also played more games than anyone around us (and indeed, more than anyone else in the division). So maybe the table gives a slightly

false picture, although the points are on the board and it should help us to avoid the worst of potential fixture congestion during the winter. Poppies are securely in mid-table, they had a very disappointing run through September but a couple of good wins last month, followed by two draws in their last two games, means they'll probably be hoping to look up rather than down over the next few weeks. So this afternoon should be a good test for both. Looking ahead a little, Brock are about to get back into cup action, starting with a blockbuster on Tuesday against AFC Stoneham in the Russell Cotes Cup. Anyone who was here two weeks ago and witnessed the Badgers' excellent 3-2 win in the league game will know that this should be a really good match between two positive, progressive sides. And then, after a trip to Sherborne next weekend (bit of a trek, that one!) we're home to near neighbours New Milton Town in the Southampton Senior Cup on Tuesday week. There's always something a bit different about a cup run so let's hope we can progress in at least one of those ties.

So, Badgers v Poppies: let battle commence! Up the Badgers!

CLUB HISTORY 1898-2025

The club was founded in 1898, initially playing close to the Rhinefield Ornamental Drive. The Badgers were founder members of the New Forest League which they won a number of times. They moved before World War 1 to a site between the Rose and Crown and Snakecatcher pubs. Following the war the club played in both the Bournemouth and Hampshire leagues, moving to Fathersfield. In 1931 they were forced to move again, to Black Knoll when Fathersfield was given over to housing. In 1935 the club won the New Forest Lads Cup. Within two years the Badgers moved to Oberfield and after World War 2 they spent some seasons at Tile Barn before moving to their current home at Grigg Lane in 1951.

The club were crowned Hampshire League Division Three champions in 1960 as well as winning the Bournemouth Seniors cup. They moved between the Second and Third divisions until in 1971 they were promoted to Division One where they won the league title in the 1975-76 season. Brockenhurst were founder members of the Wessex League, joining in 1986. The club's FA Cup giant killing reached its pinnacle in season 2001/02 when Kingstonian were defeated and in season 2004/05 the club reached the 3rd qualifying round, the run ending in defeat to Bath City.

In season 2012/13 the club returned to the Wessex Premier Division as Division One champions and reached the final of both the Southampton DFA Senior Cup and the Wessex League Cup. The Badgers won three cups in three years—in season 2019/20 the team won the Bournemouth Senior Cup; in 2020/21 we lifted the Hampshire Senior Invitational Supplementary Cup; and in 2021/22 we won the Russell-Cotes Cup. In 2020/21, both the U18 and U17 teams won their divisions. Season 2021/22 was one of the most successful for Brockenhurst in recent years, with the club finishing 6th in the Premier Division, getting to the last 16 in the FA Vase and winning the Russell-Cotes Cup. Brockenhurst celebrated its 125th season in 2023/24, and missed out on the promotion playoffs by goal difference only. At the end of the season, long-serving manager Pat McManus left the club; a successful and enjoyable testimonial match was held for Pat in July 2024.

We recently appointed Steve Devlin as first-team manager of Brockenhurst. We have retained the core of the squad from last year's campaign, and added experience, some returning players and a number of promising players. The future looks bright for The Badgers.



BOURNEMOUTH POPIES CLUB HISTORY

The club – initially named Bournemouth Rovers – was founded at a meeting presided over by Alderman J Nethercoate (later Mayor of Bournemouth) on 11 September 1875. It is one of the oldest clubs in the country being founder Members of the Football Association, the Hampshire FA and the Bournemouth FA. After a brief spell as Bournemouth Dean Park, the name Bournemouth FC was adopted in 1889 having amalgamated with another local side- Bournemouth Arabs. The club's nickname comes from the poppy red colour which was adopted in 1895/6.

The club was among founder members of the Hampshire League and up to joining the Wessex League in 1986 had played entirely in the Hampshire League, except for a short spell at the turn of the 20th century. Earliest record of playing in the FA Cup was a 6-0 defeat at Kennington Oval against Old Westminster on 1 November 1884, and the club played the second game in the inaugural Hampshire League campaign of 1896/97. The club has had three homes during its history - East Common near the Bournemouth railway station, Dean Park (current home of Dorset County Cricket) and now Victoria Park, which was formerly a farmer's field. The first taste of County success came in winning the West Division in 1905. Poppies became County Division Champions either side of the Great War, picking up the Hampshire League Shield in 1913, with Wheeler scoring 76 goals that season from 47 matches including 9 in a 19 day period. The furthest progress in the FA Amateur Cup came at that time as well, reaching the 3rd Round in 1923/24. In 1929 the club was relegated to Division 2 and there were only brief spells in the top flight until the club joined the newly-formed Wessex League in 1985.

The new clubhouse was opened in 1985- just in time for entering the Wessex League and the current 205-seater stand provides adequate cover from the elements with several rows of bench seating replacing the old wooden stand that was destroyed by fire during 1974. This stretches about a third of the length of the pitch – next to the glass-fronted clubhouse.

The Wessex League Championship has remained elusive, coming close on two occasions with a 3rd place in 1990/91 under the guidance of Tommy Taylor and runners up spot in 1994/5 to Fleet Town when Alex Pike was the manager. The first piece of silverware for a number of years arrived in 2010/11, in the 25th Wessex League season, in the shape of the League Cup, with a 1-0 win over Winchester City. 2011/12 saw the team reach the FA Carlsberg Vase Quarter Final for the first time- going out to 0-2 in a home reverse against West Auckland Town.



BROCKENHURST —08 NOVEMBER 2025

This wasn't quite the classic "game of two halves", but not far short. In the first period, the Badgers were dominant: controlling the ball and territory, but not finding their cutting edge to turn it into goals. Possession, position and a home defence which seemed on the verge of panic on several occasions but, credit to the Church, they dug in and they cleared pretty much everything thrown at them. There was one notable exception; 24 minutes, Dylan WALKER picking up the ball on the left, cutting inside, shot blocked but straight back to him so he took the ball past another player and found the far corner from the edge of the box. A stunning goal, the least the Badgers deserved, but there was that lingering feeling that they might be made to pay for not creating the chances to extend the lead. Well into injury time they were given a reminder of why that mattered – one long ball forward, chased down by Joe Freak (who covered an astonishing amount of ground all afternoon), managed to get a shot away from a tight angle – saved by Valero but the rebound back to Freak and he drove it across goal but nobody had followed him in and that was half-time. The hosts made a couple of tweaks at half-time and played with a bit more intensity. Brock survived the first five-minute onslaught and seemed to have regained their control, but Church grabbed that initiative back with some real energy, doubling up on Holmes and gradually winning the midfield battle. Toghill shot wide from a presentable position... then on the hour, the hosts won a corner which somehow went straight through the area, flicking off a defender for another corner – this one leading to pinball in the box before Lewis FREAK smashed home the equaliser. Half an hour to go, but the defences were mostly on top for the remainder of the game, with remarkably little goalmouth action. Brock didn't get the rub of many decisions, especially in their attacking third, but for the second time in a week they didn't really create enough, while mostly keeping their opponents at arm's length. A draw was, ultimately, probably fair enough. FT 1-1






