WELCOME FROM THE CHAIRMAN

Good afternoon and welcome to the Meadens Skoda Arena, Grigg Lane for this afternoon's visit of Horndean in the Wessex Premier League. No doubt Horndean will, as always, provide a tough test this afternoon and we can anticipate a close, hard fought, contest.

After a bright start to the season the Badgers have been hampered by injuries and forced to field a young side who, despite valiant efforts, have struggled in the last couple of games. I was at Bashley on the bank holiday Saturday last weekend to watch them go down 2-4 in a game that was significantly impacted by the weather. Playing against the wind in the first half the Badgers were 0-2 down at the break but rallied in the second half to level in the 84th minute only to run out of steam in the dying minutes. Losing 2 players immediately before kickoff significantly hampered the team and the result didn't really reflect the run of play.

The hot dry summer has finally broken and we have had some much-needed rain over the last 10 days. The pitch has held up well in the face of the dry weather and the inevitable traffic while contractors have been installing our new floodlights over the last 2 weeks. (More on them next Tuesday when we get to try them out first the first time against Fareham Town in the Hampshire Senior Cup). Thanks once to Steve and Burt for presenting a first-class playing surface once again.

Unfortunately we struggled with numbers for a variety of reasons and

were forced to make the difficult decision not to field a competitive u18 side this season. However, every cloud has a silver lining and we are delighted that our u15 boys' team will be playing their home fixtures at Grigg Lane this season ... starting with a friendly which will be played on Wednesday evening after I submit these notes. It is really great to see the youth teams playing more frequently at Grigg Lane. Good luck boys ... enjoy your games at Grigg Lane ... you are the future of the club!

After the success of last September's fixture I am delighted the ExSaints will be returning to face the Brock Legends again this season on Friday 25 September. The fixture raises funds which are split between Brockenhurst Youth FC and good local causes supported by the ExSaints. It was a great event last year attended by more than 800 supporters. The ExSaints players were hugely generous with their time, particularly with the many kids attending, signing autographs and posing for selfies long after the final whistle, as they no doubt will do again this year. Tickets go on sale shortly, put Friday 25 September in your diary!

As I said at the top of my notes, Horndean will provide a stern test so the Badgers will need us all to get behind them this afternoon. So let's back the boys and make some noise! Come on you Badgers!

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CLUB HISTORY 1898-2026

The club was founded in 1898, initially playing close to the Rhinefield Ornamental Drive. The Badgers were founder members of the New Forest League which they won a number of times. They moved before World War 1 to a site between the Rose and Crown and Snakecatcher pubs. Following the war the club played in both the Bournemouth and Hampshire leagues, moving to Fathersonfield. In 1931 they were forced to move again, to Black Knoll when Fathersonfield was given over to housing. In 1935 the club won the New Forest Lads Cup. Within two years the Badgers moved to Oberfield and after World War 2 they spent some seasons at Tile Barn before moving to their current home at Grigg Lane in 1951.

The club were crowned Hampshire League Division Three champions in 1960 as well as winning the Bournemouth Seniors cup. They moved between the Second and Third divisions until in 1971 they were promoted to Division One where they won the league title in the 1975-76 season.

Brockenhurst were founder members of the Wessex League, joining in 1986. The club's FA Cup giant killing reached its pinnacle in season 2001/02 when Kingstonsian were defeated and in season 2004/05 the club reached the 3rd qualifying round, the run ending in defeat to Bath City.

In season 2012/13 the club returned to the Wessex Premier Division as Division One champions and reached the final of both the Southampton DFA Senior Cup and the Wessex League Cup. The Badgers won three cups in three years—in season 2019/20 the team won the Bournemouth Senior Cup; in 2020/21 we lifted the Hampshire Senior Invitational Supplementary Cup; and in 2021/22 we won the Russell-Cotes Cup. In 2020/21, both the U18 and U17 teams won their divisions.

Season 2021/22 was one of the most successful for Brockenhurst in recent years, with the club finishing 6th in the Premier Division, getting to the last 16 in the FA Vase and winning the Russell-Cotes Cup. Brockenhurst celebrated its 125th season in 2023/24, and missed out on the promotion playoffs by goal difference only. At the end of the season, long-serving manager Pat McManus left the club; a successful and enjoyable testimonial match was held for Pat in July 2024.

Steve Devlin became our first-team manager near the beginning of season 2025/26. This season, we have retained the core of the squad from last year's campaign, and added experience, some returning players and a number of promising players. The future looks bright for The Badgers.



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HORNDEAN CLUB HISTORY

The club was established in 1887 and played their first match on 27 October against Red Star from Havant. They initially played at Blendworth Hill before moving to their current ground.

The club only played friendly matches until World War One, after which they joined the Waterlooville & District League. They won the league title in 1926–27, 1929–30, 1930–31 and 1931–32. They went on to join the Portsmouth League, winning Division Two in 1953–54. They were later promoted to the Premier Division, which they won in 1968–69, 1969–70 and 1970–71.

In 1972 they moved up to Division Four of the Hampshire League. By the mid-1980s they had reached Division One, and became founder members of the Wessex Football League in 1986. The Deans struggled to make an impact on the league and in nine seasons never once managed to finish in the top half. After finishing bottom of the league in 1994–95, they were relegated back to the Hampshire League, where they remained until re-joining the Wessex League as founder members of the new Division Two in 2004.

In 2010–11 they were promoted to the Premier Division after finishing as runners-up in Division One. In October 2015 long serving manager David Carter left the club and on Wednesday 21 October 2015 Portsmouth Academy Coach Craig Pearce and Simon Chamberlain were appointed as successors. Craig Pearce and Simon Chamberlain took the team to fifth place, Horndean's highest ever position in the Wessex Premier League at the time.

The start of the 2016–2017 season Horndean saw the arrival of Michael Birmingham, Dutchy Holland, Jason Mann, and Matthew Driver. The season finished with Horndean in 6th place in the Sydenham's Wessex Premier division. The 2017–2018 Season saw the first team finish in 4th place, in 2018–2019 the team under Michael Birmingham finished second, its highest ever position in the Sydenham's Wessex Premier League. The following two seasons were curtailed due to the COVID pandemic, before Horndean recorded another strong season, ending the 2021/22 campaign in fourth place. The 2022/23 saw the Deans make history with a League & Cup double. The club's first Wessex Premier title since joining as founding members in 1986 was secured on the final day of the season in a 1-0 win over Portland United. A club record attendance of 1,359 watched on when Zack Willett headed a late winner as Horndean were crowned Champions - and with it promotion to the Isthmian League.

Just two weeks later the Deans won more silverware in the form of the Portsmouth Senior Cup, after defeating Fareham Town on penalties in the final at Fratton Park. The double was complete!

A lateral move away from the Isthmian South East Division saw the club start 2024/25 in the the South Central Division, following a 14th place finish in their first year at the higher level.

FAREHAM TOWN V BROCKENHURST 22 AUGUST—BY JON RENYARD

Despite the scoreline, a missed opportunity for the Badgers... An explosive start to the game, Brock with the kickoff, ball played forward to Ashton Palmier who controlled it on his chest, let it bounce, and hooked a swerving, curling shot into the top corner from 25 yards as keeper McCarthy stood and admired. 11 seconds on the clock, Badgers ahead with an absolute worldie. It didn't change anyone's game plan: the Creeksiders were patient without creating clear chances, Brock might have scored a second but the chances went begging: then confusion in the Fareham defence, Bennett heading back towards McCarthy who wasn't there... the keeper turned and grabbed the ball right on the line... over the line...? Only McCarthy will know! Now the hosts upped the ante, but a break for the Badgers, Walker in space – his shot cannoned back off the bar. 32 minutes, Fareham's best move to date, a flying run down the wing from Sibley, great cross, Charlie Cooper in far too much space 8 yards out – magnificent save Jordi Valero. But finally, 4 minutes from the interval, the equaliser – all far too easy, Sibley must have run 20 yards unchallenged before an angled shot which Valero reached but couldn't keep out. And then two minutes into overtime, Ryan controlled a loose ball and smashed it into the top corner from just outside the box, and the hosts had turned things around before the break. HT 2-1

Chances a-plenty in the second half too, a golden one for Brock when McCarthy could only block McGrath's shot but he got back up to block Colmer's rebound. Fareham then couldn't take advantage of an extra man when Bailey was sinbinned, although Ridge should probably have hit the target inside the box; and back to 11, another chance for the Badgers, Walker put through but denied by a fine sprawling save. On 77 the Creeksiders wrapped it up with a neat move, Stan Bridgman with a fine finish, 3-1. He was then denied by an outstanding Valero save... then another fine block from a Newman shot... but Brock had their chances too, McGrath blazed over from ten yards out, then hit a shot which hit Bennett and rolled agonisingly wide of the near post... and into overtime, another Ugwumba cross, keeper dropped it, McGrath placed his shot over. 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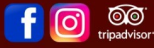
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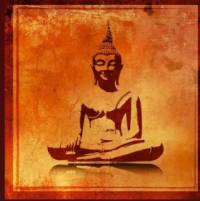
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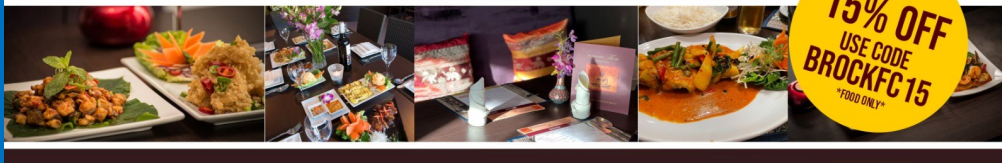
