CLUB HISTORY 1898-2025

The club was founded in 1898, initially playing close to the Rhinefield Ornamental Drive. The Badgers were founder members of the New Forest League which they won a number of times. They moved before World War 1 to a site between the Rose and Crown and Snakecatcher pubs. Following the war the club played in both the Bournemouth and Hampshire leagues, moving to Fathersfield. In 1931 they were forced to move again, to Black Knoll when Fathersfield was given over to housing. In 1935 the club won the New Forest Lads Cup. Within two years the Badgers moved to Oberfield and after World War 2 they spent some seasons at Tile Barn before moving to their current home at Grigg Lane in 1951.

The club were crowned Hampshire League Division Three champions in 1960 as well as winning the Bournemouth Seniors cup. They moved between the Second and Third divisions until in 1971 they were promoted to Division One where they won the league title in the 1975-76 season. Brockenhurst were founder members of the Wessex League, joining in 1986. The club's FA Cup giant killing reached its pinnacle in season 2001/02 when Kingstonian were defeated and in season 2004/05 the club reached the 3rd qualifying round, the run ending in defeat to Bath City.

In season 2012/13 the club returned to the Wessex Premier Division as Division One champions and reached the final of both the Southampton DFA Senior Cup and the Wessex League Cup. The Badgers won three cups in three years—in season 2019/20 the team won the Bournemouth Senior Cup; in 2020/21 we lifted the Hampshire Senior Invitational Supplementary Cup; and in 2021/22 we won the Russell-Cotes Cup. In 2020/21, both the U18 and U17 teams won their divisions. Season 2021/22 was one of the most successful for Brockenhurst in recent years, with the club finishing 6th in the Premier Division, getting to the last 16 in the FA Vase and winning the Russell-Cotes Cup. Brockenhurst celebrated its 125th season in 2023/24, and missed out on the promotion playoffs by goal difference only. At the end of the season, long-serving manager Pat McManus left the club; a successful and enjoyable testimonial match was held for Pat in July 2024.

We recently appointed Steve Devlin as first-team manager of Brockenhurst. We have retained the core of the squad from last year's campaign, and added experience, some returning players and a number of promising players. The future looks bright for The Badgers.

LAVERSTOCK + FORD CLUB HISTORY

Laverstock & Ford FC, established in 1956, has experienced a journey marked by promotions, relegations, and cup successes. The club rose from Division 3B in the Salisbury & District League to the league's Division 1 in 1963.

The club entered the Salisbury & District Premier League in 1984–85, where the club finished runners-up and won the Stonehenge Cup. Between 1985–1991, Laverstock joined the Wiltshire League. In 1991–92, they returned to the Salisbury & District Premier, and briefly joined the Hampshire League before returning in 1993–94, collecting multiple local cup wins.

Rejoining the Hampshire League in 1999–2000, the club won the Wiltshire Junior Cup in 2000 and the Bledisloe Cup in 2002–03. They later entered the Sydenham Wessex League, earning promotion to Division 1 in 2005–06. In 2007–08, after ground improvements and a Wiltshire Senior Cup final appearance, they gained promotion to the Wessex Premier Division.

Though early years in the Wessex Premier saw modest finishes and early cup exits, the 2010–11 season marked their best league performance. Relegated in 2011–12, the club focused on rebuilding and stabilised in Division One under Robbie Lakeman, returning to its community-focused roots.

The club developed under the Chairman leadership of Kristian Guyatt and in 2022, Lavvy finally returned to the Wessex Premier Division as they won the first ever play off final 3-2 AET when defeating Newport IOW. It was a season that was almost never was for Lavvy, after the tragic passing of player Freddie Jones Fontete in February 2022, Laverstock & Ford somehow found the strength to win 13 games in a row to achieve what looked so far out of reach.

Since then The Bulldogs have developed themselves into a stable Premier side, with back to back 8th-place finishes and a 13th place finish in 2024/25 but also reaching the last 64 of the FA Vase and their memorable FA Cup run to the 2nd Qualfiying Round where they lost 1-0 to National League side Taunton Town in 2022/23. Kristian has been joined by Dan Newman formerly chairman at Downton and between them continue to give Liam and his team the structure and support they need. Liam has seen good coaches come and go, Harry Fryer making a huge impact in his three seasons as Head Coach and with Elliott Cooke and Rae Hughes joining Liam in the bootroom the group look forward to evolving the team even more.

LAST TIME OUT ...

JON RENYARD'S REVIEW OF BROCKENHURST VAFO STONEHAM-01 NOVEMBER 2025

This was truly an outstanding advert for the Wessex League between two fine sides. A bright, open start to the game – two teams testing each other out, the first real danger on 11 minutes from the visitors, Martins with a cross, Sampson the header, tipped over by Valero. Gradually, the Purps upped their game and started to dominate possession and territory: free kicks, corners, crosses... It felt inevitable that the visitors would find a breakthrough – Martins missed a couple of presentable opportunities, Valero with a couple of fine saves – but the goal finally came on the half-hour in the cruellest fashion, a shot from Cluett heading wide of the far post but it struck Rossi and was diverted in for an own goal. Within four, Brock could have been level, a brilliant run from Holmes sending Bent in on goal but his shot came back off the post and away. Small margins... HT 0-1 Within four minutes of the restart, Holmes had shot just wide from the edge of the box. Another spell of Stoneham pressure, resisted – but then Valero with a careless clearance straight to Martins, excellent block from Macfarlane but the ball rolled loose to Sampson and he finished into the roof of the net, 0-2. But these current Badgers are resilient. 64 minutes, livewire Beale with another super run down the right, pulled back to Bent, shot blocked but turned home by Holmes at the back post to give Brock a lifeline. Now the Purps were playing on the break and taking their time whenever possible, and Brock had the conch. 12 minutes from time, star man Luke Holmes, knocked over in a tackle but getting up and going again, chipping a cross to the back post, Dylan Walker rising high above everyone, perfect header back across goal to level things up. Valero gave the visitors a chance to retake the lead when he cleared straight to Sampson, but Rossi made an excellent interception. Three minutes to go... another Brock attack, the ball half-cleared towards the edge of the area, returned on the volley with interest by Walker, smashing home his second and Brock's third. Right on 90 minutes, a Stoneham free kick caused mayhem in the area, so many legs and bodies involved and and to be honest I'm not guite sure how it ended up in Valero's grateful arms. Even then, time for a diving save by Valero to deny a Fee free kick, the last meaningful action of a highly entertaining match. FT 3-2
