CLUB HISTORY 1898-2025

The club was founded in 1898, initially playing close to the Rhinefield Ornamental Drive. The Badgers were founder members of the New Forest League which they won a number of times. They moved before World War 1 to a site between the Rose and Crown and Snakecatcher pubs. Following the war the club played in both the Bournemouth and Hampshire leagues, moving to Fathersfield. In 1931 they were forced to move again, to Black Knoll when Fathersfield was given over to housing. In 1935 the club won the New Forest Lads Cup. Within two years the Badgers moved to Oberfield and after World War 2 they spent some seasons at Tile Barn before moving to their current home at Grigg Lane in 1951.

The club were crowned Hampshire League Division Three champions in 1960 as well as winning the Bournemouth Seniors cup. They moved between the Second and Third divisions until in 1971 they were promoted to Division One where they won the league title in the 1975-76 season. Brockenhurst were founder members of the Wessex League, joining in 1986. The club's FA Cup giant killing reached its pinnacle in season 2001/02 when Kingstonian were defeated and in season 2004/05 the club reached the 3rd qualifying round, the run ending in defeat to Bath City.

In season 2012/13 the club returned to the Wessex Premier Division as Division One champions and reached the final of both the Southampton DFA Senior Cup and the Wessex League Cup. The Badgers won three cups in three years—in season 2019/20 the team won the Bournemouth Senior Cup; in 2020/21 we lifted the Hampshire Senior Invitational Supplementary Cup; and in 2021/22 we won the Russell-Cotes Cup. In 2020/21, both the U18 and U17 teams won their divisions. Season 2021/22 was one of the most successful for Brockenhurst in recent years, with the club finishing 6th in the Premier Division, getting to the last 16 in the FA Vase and winning the Russell-Cotes Cup. Brockenhurst celebrated its 125th season in 2023/24, and missed out on the promotion playoffs by goal difference only. At the end of the season, long-serving manager Pat McManus left the club; a successful and enjoyable testimonial match was held for Pat in July 2024.

We recently appointed Steve Devlin as first-team manager of Brockenhurst. We have retained the core of the squad from last year's campaign, and added experience, some returning players and a number of promising players. The future looks bright for The Badgers.

AFC STONEHAM CLUB HISTORY

The Club was founded in 1919 as the Royal Engineers (Ordnance Survey Office) FC by soldiers returning from the First World War, although there is a record of matches being played by Ordnance Survey Royal Engineers against The Gentlemen of Tenby in 1888. The club simplified its name in 1929 to Ordnance Survey. The first team won the Premier Division of the Southampton Senior League in 1996/97. The Civil Service Ground was closed at the end of 98/99, and 'Survey' were temporarily relocated to Lordshill Recreation Ground before moving to their new home ground at Stoneham Park in 2002.

The club changed its name to Stoneham in 2006 and a year later decided to enhance the name by adding 'AFC' to Stoneham, which had an immediate effect with AFC Stoneham winning the Hampshire Premier League in the 2007/08 season and reaching the final of the league's Senior Cup.

In 2015, the Club earned promotion to the Wessex League. The first team ventured into the FA Vase for the first time in season 16/17, and beat two clubs from the Hellenic League, before losing to Shaftesbury.

Season 17/18 saw us improve our league position to 5th whilst reaching the final of the Russell-Cotes Cup, losing to Wessex Premier Division Champions Andover Town 1-0 in the final at their ground in front of over 500 people.

During the 18/19 season, the first XI went 20 league games without defeat, one of only three teams at our level in the country to do so as we pushed for promotion to the Wessex Premier Division.

In the same season, for the first time in our 100-year history, we entered the FA Cup and had tremendous victories at AFC Portchester and at home against Westfield. Sadly, our adventure was curtailed by Cirencester Town in the next round at home in front of over 350 supporters. Prior to the Cirencester game, and as the lowest ranked team left in the competition, we had a visit from the FA Cup with many of our junior players and First Team present for photos on a memorable day which brought the club TV and national newspaper coverage. Our first ever FA Cup adventure will live in the memory for a very long time.

We finished the 18/19 season as Wessex Division One champions, securing promotion to the Wessex Premier Division.

Due to Covid-19, the 25/26 season will only be the club's fifth full season in the Wessex Premier Division, having finished third in 22/23, second in 23/24 but eventually succumbing to Shaftesbury in the play off final and second again in 24/25 but losing out in the play-off semi-final.

The club enter the 24/25 season with optimism and look forward to its adult and youth sections continuing their growth and progression.

JON RENYARD'S REVIEW OF BROCKENHURSTA BOURNEMOUTH POPPIES—15 NOVEMBER 2025

Somewhat unexpectedly given the forecast, this game went ahead – the pitch was always going to be heavy but to be fair to Brock, they managed to play some very decent football on their way to a comfortable home win. Within two minutes, Beale skinned his defender but pulled his shot wide of the near post. Opening goal, 14 minutes - Bailey fouled a couple of inches from the corner of the box, a perfect free kick from Holmes headed home by Mitch Speechley-Price. More opportunities came and went – Holmes chipped over the bar from a tight angle with the keeper stranded, Brooks with a powerful shot which keeper Plunkett fumbled round the near post, Beale with a piledriver from a tight angle, brilliantly tipped over. One moment of alarm for the Badgers when Valero called for a cross but Steel got his header in first and the ball sailed over his own crossbar. Back came Brock on 25, another flowing move, Beale again involved and a switch to Holmes on the left, another great cross but Speechley-Price headed over. No matter: wind forward two minutes, Beale this time down the left, excellent overlapping run from Torniainen who was flattened by Zdrava; obvious penalty, coolly converted by Speechley-Price. It was no less than Brock deserved. Just before half-time, another brilliant run and cross from the irrepressible Beale, Speechley-Price couldn't quite get enough on it 8 yards out and the ball bounced wide. HT 2-0 Poppies were better in the second half, and at times they moved the ball quite well without fashioning clear chances, mostly foundering on an excellent Brock back line, with Macfarlane again outstanding. Brock might have extended their lead on 54, yet another mazy run from Beale but the angle was tight for McCarthy-Gardiner and Plunkett saved well. 57 minutes, the goal to settle things. Speechley-Price took a free kick from near the touchline, Rhys Taylor went up for the defensive header and it looped up... back... and over every despairing lunge into the net for a pretty obvious oggy. So, 3-0, after which Brock failed to take so many chances... Beale's header from a very tight angle bouncing off the post and grabbed by Plunkett; an excellent move between Holmes and Brooks, Plunkett finally diving bravely at the latter's feet inside the box; Beale twice played in inside the last couple of minutes, identical positions on the left, identical excellent saves from Plunkett. Poppies created half-chances late on, but the points had long
