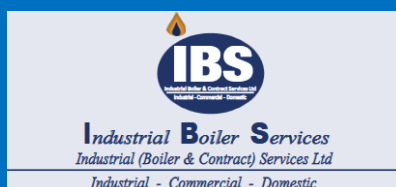

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CLUB HISTORY 1898-2026

The club was founded in 1898, initially playing close to the Rhinefield Ornamental Drive. The Badgers were founder members of the New Forest League which they won a number of times. They moved before World War 1 to a site between the Rose and Crown and Snakecatcher pubs. Following the war the club played in both the Bournemouth and Hampshire leagues, moving to Fathersonfield. In 1931 they were forced to move again, to Black Knoll when Fathersonfield was given over to housing. In 1935 the club won the New Forest Lads Cup. Within two years the Badgers moved to Oberfield and after World War 2 they spent some seasons at Tile Barn before moving to their current home at Grigg Lane in 1951.

The club were crowned Hampshire League Division Three champions in 1960 as well as winning the Bournemouth Seniors cup. They moved between the Second and Third divisions until in 1971 they were promoted to Division One where they won the league title in the 1975-76 season.

Brockenhurst were founder members of the Wessex League, joining in 1986. The club's FA Cup giant killing reached its pinnacle in season 2001/02 when Kingstonsian were defeated and in season 2004/05 the club reached the 3rd qualifying round, the run ending in defeat to Bath City.

In season 2012/13 the club returned to the Wessex Premier Division as Division One champions and reached the final of both the Southampton DFA Senior Cup and the Wessex League Cup. The Badgers won three cups in three years—in season 2019/20 the team won the Bournemouth Senior Cup; in 2020/21 we lifted the Hampshire Senior Invitational Supplementary Cup; and in 2021/22 we won the Russell-Cotes Cup. In 2020/21, both the U18 and U17 teams won their divisions.

Season 2021/22 was one of the most successful for Brockenhurst in recent years, with the club finishing 6th in the Premier Division, getting to the last 16 in the FA Vase and winning the Russell-Cotes Cup. Brockenhurst celebrated its 125th season in 2023/24, and missed out on the promotion playoffs by goal difference only. At the end of the season, long-serving manager Pat McManus left the club; a successful and enjoyable testimonial match was held for Pat in July 2024.

Steve Devlin became our first-team manager near the beginning of season 2025/26. This season, we have retained the core of the squad from last year's campaign, and added experience, some returning players and a number of promising players. The future looks bright for The Badgers.

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SANDHURST TOWN CLUB HISTORY

Sandhurst Football Club was formed in 1910 and played in the Reading & District League until 1979 apart from a short spell in the East Berkshire Football League. In 1979 the club was elected into the Aldershot & District Football League. 1984 saw the club finish as runner-up and then become founder members of the Chiltonian Football League. The best season in this League was in 1986/87 when they finished in second place. In 1990 the Club applied for membership of the Combined Counties Football League and was granted senior status by the Berks & Bucks County Football Association.

The first ground used by the Club was a field adjacent to the Bull & Butcher public house that may well have been used as the club headquarters. After a few years, a move was made to the Memorial Park where the Club remained until the 1996 close season. The introduction of the National Lottery prompted an immediate bid for funding for a new ground in Bottom Meadow adjacent to the Memorial Park. With support from Bracknell Forest Borough Council and Sandhurst Town Council, the Club was successful in the first round of allocations by the National Lotteries Charities Board. The new facilities opened in August 1997 at a cost of £265,000. The club celebrated its Centenary season in 2010/11 winning the Combined Counties League Cup and reaching the semi-finals in two other competitions. Aimed at ensuring the longevity of the club for a further 100 years and beyond, a major project focused on upgrading and enhancing our facilities at Bottom Meadow; this work was completed for the start of the 2021/22 season. A state-of-the-art 3G pitch, the first of its kind in the UK, was installed during the summer of 2023.

In 2022, Jordan Ive took over the reins as first team manager and led the Fizzers to the Combined Counties Division One title and promotion to Step 5 into the Combined Counties Premier South. Sadly, ownership and operational changes in the running of Bottom Meadow during 2024/25 hampered our progress and we could not muster enough points to avoid relegation back into Combined Counties Division One. We are delighted that Carl Barrie has returned as the new Fizzers manager for the 2026/27 season. Carl, along with his management team will lead the Fizzers into a new era and a new league, after a change in league allocation we join the Wessex Football League for the first time.

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RECENTLY ...

PETERSFIELD TOWN V BROCKENHURST 11 SEPTEMBER —BY JON RENYARD

This was not, as they say, the prettiest game of football you'll ever see. The swirling wind made the bouncing ball tricky all afternoon, and these were two young sides maybe lacking enough natural leaders to enable them to gain a measure of control... it was all a bit frenetic and patternless in the first half. Some individual moments but no early chances, but then, calamity for the hosts on 15 – some nice interplay on the right from Brock but the Rams had the cross covered... until defender and goalkeeper collided, and Harry McGrath passed the ball into an empty net. Alfie Stringer and George Comben both caught the eye for the hosts, keeping the defenders honest, Comben once beating the offside trap before shooting rather tamely. Up the other end, Makhloufi contrived to beat about five players with his close control but shot straight at Greenfield. And right on half-time, Freddie Beeson shot from distance, good diving save from Stainer-Reid. HT 0-1

The Rams started the second half with renewed endeavour, and put the Badgers on the back foot. One decent move on 53 minutes, the ball moved across to Stephens-Truman in far too much space 25 yards out – fierce shot, superb one-handed save from Stainer-Reid... but the Badgers held firm and started to create chances, a cross from Ugwumba which Giles put just past his own post.... and then finally Brock's second, 71 minutes, typical clever feet from Makhloufi trying to make space for a shot which cannoned off a couple of defenders and fell to Toby Colmer, 12 yards out, didn't look like he got all of the ball but he got enough and it nestled in the corner of the net. That seemed to knock the stuffing out of the hosts. Controversy followed when Makhloufi was clearly held back by Giles, yes it was 40 yards from goal but he was clean through and a yellow card was surprisingly lenient. But Brock should have added to their tally in the closing stages, the best chance falling to Colmer who brought the ball down brilliantly but saw Greenfield make a fine close-range save. and with two minutes to go, the hosts might have had a lifeline when the ball bounced through to Charlie Wakefield, surely several yards offside but no flag... and Stainer-Reid smothered the shot to preserve the clean sheet. 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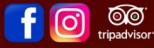
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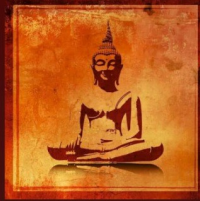
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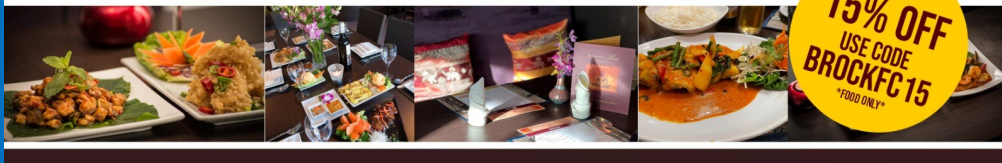
